During the service on Ash Wednesday, parishioners proceed to the front of the church and the ashes are placed on each persons forehead in the shape of a cross. DONATION POINT TAP TERMINAL Have you ever reached into your pocket during the collection, only to realise you don't have cash? We have the solution! We have installed a Donation Point Tap Terminal in the main foyer of the Church. It provides parishioners and visitors who do not carry cash and are not subscribed to our Stewardship Program with a way of donating towards our weekly loose collection. The machine is set to collect a donation of \$5 per tap. If you want to donate \$25, for example, simply tap your card five times. Thank you for your ongoing support and generosity.






