Joint parental consent is required in the majority of cases however, there are some exemptions – these can be discussed with your practitioner at any time. Consent can also be withdrawn at any time by communicating with your practitioner.

It is important to understand that:

- Within legal limitations, and our organisation's ethical guidelines, sessions with children and young people are confidential.
- No report will be issued unless required by law/or governed by court orders.
- Oral information may be provided to a Child Representative appointed by the Court, in accordance with the Family Court's Child Representative Role Guidelines.
